Can you please tell me what the current situation is in respect of the signing of the legal agreements (Section 106 agreements) to enable development work in North Colchester, involving land controlled by your Trust, to commence? I write specifically in relation to the Community Stadium where building work should have commenced some time ago had public pronouncements from your Trust been carried out in accordance with what the general public was led to believe were the genuine intentions of the three public parties (including your Trust) who some months ago I recall issued a statement to the local media to this effect.

I have now been advised by the Chief Executive of Colchester Borough Council that the Section 106 Agreement has still not been signed by either the North Essex Mental Health Trust or English Partnerships! Why the continued delay? When will the Agreement be signed?

I have to express extreme displeasure at the delay upon delay upon delay in which your Trust cannot escape criticism for its performance.
